SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must be a resident of Michigan
- Must be at least a Senior in High School
- Must attend or plan to attend a two or four-year College or University or trade school.
- Must be currently enrolled in the MI SHOWS program and have been actively involved with the MI SHOWS program for at least 3 years for 2022 Scholarship.
- Cannot be a previous MI SHOWS Scholarship winner.

MI SHOWS will administer the scholarship program, a committee will read essays and select winners. Essays will be judged on the basis of clarity of expression, persuasiveness, originality and relevance of topic.

Once we receive your application, you will receive a confirmation e-mail within five business days. It is your responsibility to ensure that all required material has been enclosed. Applications that are not complete at the time of submission will be ineligible.

All applications must be post marked by May 27, 2022.

All applicants will be notified of winners in July 2022 through email and at the annual awards banquet.

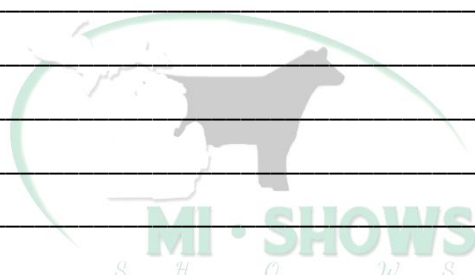
